## Track-Fast project started

In November 2008 the EU project 'Track-Fast', in which EFFoST is a partner, was launched in Porto, Portugal.

Track Fast is an acronym for Training Requirements And Careers for Knowledge-based Food Science and Technology

in Europe.

The consortium consists of 26 partners and is managed by the USB, Porto, Portugal.

EFFoST is involved in different sub-groups (WPs), and during the meeting an overview

of activities by European universities and other partners to increase awareness of food science was presented.
